Dear Parents, Carers and Pupils,

Good morning everyone. I hope that you've all had a good break over half term.

I'm sure that you have already heard the announcement from the Prime Minister last night. Great News!! We are now on countdown to welcoming you all back to school very soon. Only 9 more days (including today) of remote learning to go and then on Monday 8th March we can open our doors again to you all. I think it's safe to say that school will not be back to normal on that date. There will still be many measures that we have to put in place to ensure that you are all as safe as possible. My job for today is to review the latest guidance that the Government have released today and to update our risk assessment.
